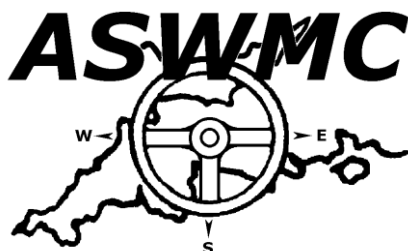
**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

1. The Midland Automobile Club (Est. 1901) Limited will organise a Clubmans Permit Sporting Trial on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021 at **Shelsley Walsh Hill Climb, Shelsley Walsh, Worcester, WR6 6RP**
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.  
This event is a round of the TBC
3. Motorsport UK Permit Number : TBC  
Waiver of Motorsport UK Championship number:
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, competitors in the TBC members of the following clubs:-

5. All competitors, drivers and passengers must produce a minimum Motorsport UK RS Clubman valid competition licence, club membership card and championship registration card (if applicable). Passengers must also carry a valid invited club membership card (Motorsport UK rule T3.1.6). BTRDA Trials Passenger cards will be accepted.
6. The programme of the meeting will be:  
Signing-on and Scrutineering starts at 8.30am  
Any competitor not signed on by 9.45am may be excluded  
First car starts at 10.00am
7. Public roads will not be used to link sections.  
There will be a minimum of eight sections on private land, each of which will be attempted three times (weather permitting).  
The entry will be split into groups starting at different sections.
8. The event will consist of classes as follows:
  - a. Red Independent
  - b. Red Live Axle
  - c. Blue Independent
  - d. Blue Live Axle
  - e. Rookie
  - f. Post Historic (can run to their own regulations and can use any of the previous or current listed tyres in the Motorsport UK Yearbook).
  - g. Invitations Class (cars outside the BTRDA & Motorsport UK Championship Regulations. These cars will not be classified in the overall results for the day).

All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations and with the National Trials Car Formula

9. Awards will be presented as follows:  
Best performance of the day (and passenger) - MAC Cup and award  
Best performance by a member of MAC not winning MAC Cup (and passenger) – an award  
1<sup>st</sup> in each class (and passengers) – an award  
The “best performance” awards may be won in any class.  
All awards are perpetual except for the MAC Cup which is held for not more than eleven months. Due to COVID-19 restrictions these will not be presented on the day. They will be sent in the post.

10. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes finally on **Tuesday 20th April 2021**. The entry fee is £49.00  
All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.  
Entry fees will be banked as received. Entries cancelled 14 days or more prior to the meeting will be refunded in full less a £15.00 administration charge. Entries cancelled between 7 and 13 days prior to the meeting will be refunded in full less a £40.00 administration charge. Entries cancelled less than 7 days prior to the meeting may be refunded Motorsport UK per capita charges only, upon application to the Secretary of the Meeting.  
In the unfortunate situation of the cancellation of an event as a result of circumstance beyond our control, e.g force majeure, viral pandemic, dictates from Government and/or Motorsport UK etc. We will propose returning of event fees less actual costs, up to a maximum of £15. However there will also be the option to forward the entry fee to next season.

12. The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 50. The minimum is 20.  
Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.  
Entries will be taken in order of receipt up to the maximum.  
A ballot will be drawn to determine order of running.  
Entry fees will be refunded to those withdrawing before the closing date, subject to a £5 administration fee.

14. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.1.2.
16. Starting numbers will be allocated by ballot prior to the event.
17. Competitors will be identified by number cards which will be issued by the organisers.
18. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations.
19. Minimum tyre pressure will be advised by the Clerk of the Course on the day dependent on prevailing conditions. Checks will be made.  
In any event minimum tyre pressure will be 2 p.s.i. (please present your car at scrutineering with a minimum of 5 p.s.i. in the rear tyres).
20. A brake test will be undertaken at scrutineering together with safety checks. Differential seal numbers will be checked at Scrutineering.

21. No person may drive a competing car on the site unless he or she has signed an indemnity and then only in the competition.
22. Final instructions will be posted on the Monday prior to the event.
23. Please note that to be included in results for championships the tyres allowed are:  
  
Nankang CX668, Vredestein T-Trac 2, Maxxis MA-510N or Toyo 330
24. The MAC take COVID-19 preparations seriously, all the information regarding our protocols will be in the Final Instructions issued to Competitors before a meeting.
25. GDPR - I am happy for the MAC to retain my details and to contact me in regard to specific events organised by the MAC, where there are opportunities for official and marshals to participate. I understand that the MAC will not use the details supplied for any other purpose other than MAC activities.
